Home sales are up 13.6% across Canada, with 63,335 units sold in June 2021, compared to 55,776 in June 2020.




+1.4%

New listings are up 1.4% across Canada, with 86,632 new listings added in June 2021, compared to 85,421 in June 2020.



+25.9%

The average price of homes sold across Canada in June 2021 was \$679,051, up 25.9% from \$539,182 in June 2020.
